Edwards Street Municipal Parking Field

June 1, 2013 - May 31, 2014

- If you currently have a parking space, you will receive a renewal form the beginning of May.
- If you are interested in obtaining a parking space, contact Debbie Cantileno at 621-1961.
- Parking Permits expire on May 31st.
- Permit fee for one year is \$384.
- Sticker must be displayed on the rear bumper so that it is visible at all times, or a summons may be issued.
- Guest sticker for the same space is an additional \$42 per year.
- Guest sticker must be displayed inside the rear window of the guest vehicle, or a summons may be issued.
- All vehicles must have current registration.
- No commercial vehicles are permitted.
- Vehicle must park in assigned space or will be towed at vehicle owner's risk/expense.
- A new sticker is required when a new vehicle is purchased.
- There is a \$10 fee for replacement of any lost or damaged sticker(s).
- Assigned parking space is non-transferable.
- If you sell your co-op or sublet, the parking space returns to the Village.
- Assignee is responsible for snow removal around parked vehicle.
- You must notify the Village if you move or no longer need your space. Upon producing the sticker to the Village and completing a claim form, you will receive a pro-rated refund.
- Any unpaid parking/traffic tickets owed to the Village Justice Court must be paid before a permit is issued or renewed.
- There is a one-time fee of \$50 for a closer space. Advise Village Hall, in writing, if you wish to be placed on the "Move-up" (closer space) list.
